



Dear Parents:

Welcome to a wonderful year in Kindergarten! We are looking forward to a happy and healthy year. When you buy school supplies for your child, please consider the following suggestions:

1. Please send these items in a large brown bag with your child's name on the outside of the bag:
 - a. large box of tissues
 - b. baby wipes
 - c. a roll of paper towels
2. Bags to hold your child's folder, lunchbox, etc. will be provided on the first day of school. They are color coded according to class. Please use only this bag to transport your child's belongings to and from school on a daily basis.
3. On the first day of school your child will be given a folder to use. After that you may replace the folder when needed.
4. Please put papers in child's folder and return the folder each day. **THE FOLDER MUST BE RETURNED EACH DAY.**
5. **YOU MUST COMPLETE ALL FORMS SENT HOME AND RETURN THEM TO SCHOOL THE FOLLOWING DAY.**
6. Your child will need a lunch box to keep snacks and lunch in.
7. If your child is bringing lunch, please label snacks and lunch. If your child is buying lunch or milk, please send the appropriate amount and label the envelope with your child's name and pin number (will be given out the first day of school). All money must be in an envelope. Please notify your child if he/she is buying lunch or bringing it from home on a daily basis.
8. Send in one snack each day. It must be nutritious. Some ideas are fruit, vegetables, cheese and crackers, or yogurt. **DO NOT SEND COOKIES, CAKES, CANDY, OR OTHER SUGARY SNACKS.** If snack requires a spoon, please send one in. We cannot supply spoons.
9. Please label all lunch boxes, bookbags, coats, etc. with your child's name and room number.
10. Reporting time is 9:00 A.M. Latecomers **MUST** report to the main office.
11. Dismissal time is 3:05 P.M. **PLEASE BE PROMPT** and pick up your child at the assigned door.
12. Your child should be able to take care of his/her own bathroom needs. He/She should know how to flush the toilet and wash his/her hands after using the bathroom.
13. Please make sure your child knows how to zipper his/her jacket.
14. Please tie shoelaces securely if your child does not know how to tie his/her own shoes.
15. Over the summer, please review your child's full name, address, and telephone number with him/her. Your child should be familiar with this information when beginning school. Your child should also be able to print his/her first name with only the first letter capitalized.
16. Please inform your child's teacher if your child rides the bus or goes to morning care or after care.
