To Whom It May Concern:


The Township of Union Schools has taken precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus) by beginning the school year 100% remote education for all Township of Union Public School students. We reassessed the need to remain 100% remote for all students at the November 17<sup>th</sup> board meeting and determined the previously anticipated date of return, to a hybrid program, of December 1<sup>st</sup> is not feasible at this time. In the coming weeks, another total assessment of district protocols will be conducted to determine the ability to facilitate the hybrid program (2 days in-person schooling, 3 days virtual) by February 1<sup>st</sup>.

School has officially begun, September 9<sup>th</sup>. Parents will need to assist their students in communicating with their teachers and facilitating the remote learning plan throughout the duration of remote learning.

This letter serves as documentation for families to provide to their employer for leave to remain with their students while schools are closed.
