Quarantine Period	10 days symptom free **IF VACCINATED - NO QUARANTINE UNLESS SYMPTOMATIC**	10 days min- 14 days max **IF VACCINATED NO QUARANTINE UNLESS SYMPTOMATIC**	10 days <u>OR</u> Neg. COVID test
Testing	PCR COVID test	PCR COVID test	PCR COVID test
When can you test during quarantine	b/w day 3-5 (If negative can return on day 7)	b/w day 6-7	Immediately
Other Important information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You may not return any sooner than day 7 w/ a negative PCR test You do not need to quarantine if you have had COVID in the last 90 days <u>OR</u> have been more than 2 weeks fully vaccinated 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You may not return any sooner than day 7 Continue to symptom monitor for 14 days Immediately isolate if you become symptomatic 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A doctor's note will NOT override mandatory quarantine period
