Need: Work is an integral part of adult life and individuals with autism have the ability and desire to work. Yet research highlights the disappointing employment outcomes for this group, with 90% of adults with autism either unemployed or underemployed. In addition, there are 1.5 million individuals with autism in the United States, 80% of which are under the age of 22.

There is an urgent need to improve and expand work opportunities for the increasing number of Adults with Autism and Developmental Disabilities.

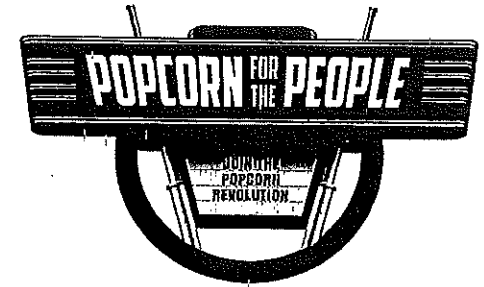

Our goal is to ensure that every adult has the opportunity to *work for good*.

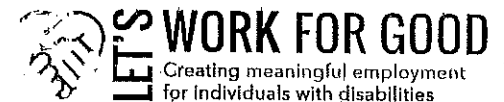

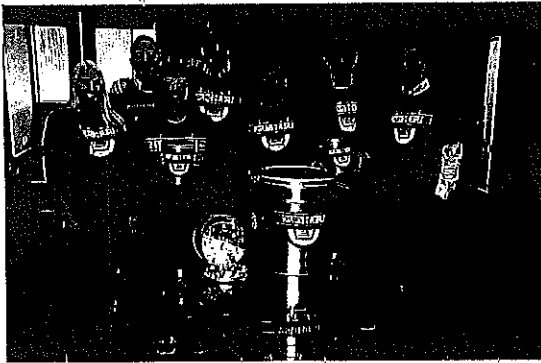
100% of profits from the *Pop In Café* will go to fund Let's Work for Good.

There was always someone in need, whether a teenager who had just lost a parent, a child who needed a kidney transplant or an adult who had run into financial trouble.

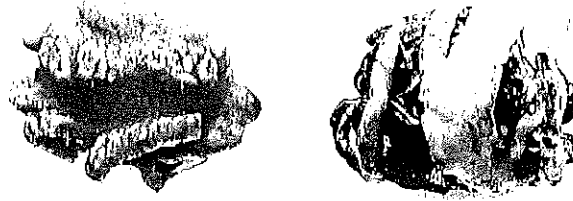
Everyone was welcome to join the community table for a good meal and lots of cheer.
