SIDELINE PASSES

The purpose of the procedure is to assure that only authorized persons, in the possession of sideline passes, occupy the sidelines during home football games.

- A. Annually a roster of those recommended as being eligible for the issuance of a sideline pass will be developed by the director of athletics. This list will be submitted to the superintendent for review and approval.
- B. It will be the responsibility of the director of athletics to manage the supply of clearly identified sideline passes and to assure that they are only issued to and used by persons on the approved list. Passes are not transferable to other persons.
- C. The distribution will be limited to those persons who have functions related to the game.
- D. Persons without a sideline pass, issued by the director of athletics, shall be directed to leave the sideline and return to the stands.
- E. Any person not leaving the sideline when directed to do so shall be escorted from the field to the stands by security personnel. Continued disruption will result in being escorted off the property owned and/or controlled by the board.
- F. Sideline passes will be withdrawn from any person found to be abusing the privileges attendant to the possession of a sideline pass.
- G. The following categories are typical of persons eligible to be considered for sideline passes:
 - a. Coaching staff
 - b. Trainer
 - c. Team physician and nurse
 - d. Authorized student participants
 - e. School administrators
 - f. Security personnel
 - g. Press/T.V.
