DISTRIBUTION OF MATERIALS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

No material shall be distributed in any school building or on school grounds, fields, parking lots or any other property under the control of the Township of Union Board of Education without prior approval of the board or its designated representative. The policy of the board of education is to prohibit the distribution of partisan political materials on or in school buildings or property.

No person is to enter into or on any school buildings, lots, fields or other school property for the purpose of distributing any political materials or other materials not previously approved.

No article may be exhibited on school property, parking lots or fields for sale or distribution, nor may photographs of pupils or property be taken without prior written approval from the superintendent and/or secretary/business administrator.

The superintendent shall create directives for the implementation of this policy.
