TUITION INCOME

The Township of Union Board of Education authorizes the business administrator/board secretary to set a tuition fee for special education or other students from outside the district in accordance with administrative code and Title 18A.

Tuition Fees for Pre-Kindergarten

The board of education approves an annual fee for all Pre-Kindergarten students who are residents of the district. All students, with the exception of those participating in the Head Start program or age appropriate for kindergarten but assigned pre-kindergarten due to an administrative decision, will be required to pay tuition.

Non-residents may attend our pre-kindergarten program providing there is space available and they or their sending district pay the tuition fee established by the board of education for non-resident students.
