

Policy

VENDING MACHINES

No food of any kind shall be sold in a school building or on school premises during the school day without express approval of the principal.

Food and drinks shall be sold to students during the school day only at regularly scheduled lunch periods and by cafeteria personnel.

No vending machines of any type shall be placed in any building or on school grounds without the approval of the board.

The sale of candy, food or beverages in competition with the school cafeteria program is prohibited. Fund raisers such as cake sales by PTA's must be conducted after cafeteria serving hours
