<input type="radio"/> Art Editor	Heads a staff that is responsible for assisting in cover design and any other art-work that is to be used in the book. Assists in page layout design.
<input type="radio"/> Copy Editor	Largely responsible for writing the copy for the book, or assigning and overseeing the writing of articles and special stories for the book by others. Also will be asked to proofread.
<input type="radio"/> Senior Section	Responsible for collecting all captions and ensuring that all names match the photos. Also helps pick the candid photos for the section.
<input type="radio"/> Sports Section	VERY IMPORTANT: Keeps track of collecting all information for sports teams and making sure that photographs have been taken for each sport early in the season.
<input type="radio"/> Club Section	Helps in the organization of the club sections, especially in the photography and identification of club officers.
<input type="radio"/> Advertising Editor	Assists in the sale of the Yearbook, and in the sales of ads and Boosters and oversees fund-raising efforts.
<input type="radio"/> Special Sections	Helps design and order the photographs for the opening of the book, the magazine section of the Yearbook, and instrumental in selecting a theme for the book.
<input type="radio"/> Underclassmen & Teachers	Helps in the organization and identification of the Teacher, Freshmen, Sophomore and Junior photos for the book, as well as the candid photos for the section. Usually given to Junior.
